6. **CONSIDERATION/ACTION** to adopt an ordinance of which the caption reads:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 62 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF WEBSTER, TEXAS ENTITLED "PARKS AND RECREATION" BY ALLOWING PERSONS WHO HAVE BEEN ISSUED A LICENSE TO CARRY AS AUTHORIZED BY THE TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE, 411.177, ISSUANCE OR DENIAL OF LICENSE, TO CARRY A HANDGUN IN WEBSTER CITY PARKS; REPEALING INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES; CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WEBSTER, TEXAS AMENDING CHAPTER 58, OFFENSES, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF WEBSTER, TEXAS, BY ADDING ARTICLE VII – "REGULATION OF SEX OFFENDER RESIDENCY" MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR CERTAIN

SEXUAL OFFENDERS TO RESIDE WITHIN 1,000 FEET OF PREMISES WHERE CHILDREN GATHER; MAKING IT ILLEGAL TO LOITER WITHIN 300 FEET OF THE PUBLIC WAY AROUND A CHILD SAFETY ZONE LOT; PROVIDING EXCEPTIONS TO THE ORDINANCES, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE ORDINANCE, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO A FINE NOT TO EXCEED \$1,000 PER DAY OF CONTINUING VIOLATION; REPEALING INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, AND FINDINGS THERETO; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WEBSTER, TEXAS FINDING THAT CENTERPOINT ENERGY HOUSTON ELECTRIC, LLC'S APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL TO AMEND ITS DISTRIBUTION COST RECOVERY FACTOR PURSUANT TO 16 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 25.243 TO INCREASE DISTRIBUTION RATES WITHIN THE CITY SHOULD BE DENIED; FINDING THAT THE CITY'S REASONABLE RATE CASE EXPENSES SHALL BE REIMBURSED BY THE COMPANY; FINDING THAT THE MEETING AT WHICH THIS RESOLUTION IS PASSED IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AS REQUIRED BY LAW; REQUIRING NOTICE OF THIS RESOLUTION TO THE COMPANY AND LEGAL COUNSEL.


